In this first workshop, Cal Poly Faculty will introduce the federal offshore wind leasing process and a primer on floating wind technology. The three wind development companies with leases from the US Department of Energy's Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (Equinor Wind US LLC, Golden State Wind LLC, and Invenergy California Offshore LLC) will also share information about previous wind projects and their proposed Morro Bay WEA projects. The second workshop in February/March 2024 will be on socioeconomic issues associated with offshore wind development. The third workshop in April/May 2024 will discuss environmental issues related to offshore wind development.
